Saxony Lutheran High School Hall of Fame

Saxony is currently accepting nominations for the Saxony Lutheran High School Hall of Fame. Nomination letters should be addressed to the Hall of Fame Committee and in care of the Athletic Director. All nominations should include the pertinent data of the individual being nominated. Eligibility requirements include any former student who has been out of school for at least eight (8) years and distinguished themselves in an extraordinary manner through their involvement in co-curricular activities may be nominated. This would include athletics, music, Scholar Bowl, or other activities in which an objective evaluation can be determined. Staff members, coaches, directors, or sponsors who have made an extraordinary contribution to the students of Saxony Lutheran High School can also be nominated for induction to the Hall of Fame. Ideally, the staff member should be retired, however, the committee can induct a current staff person if they are deemed worthy of immediate induction. Teams may be nominated as well. A nominated team must be at least eight (8) years removed from their accomplishments. Only one (1) team can be inducted every three (3) years. This is a team recognition only.
